Title: Articulatory Settings of Japanese-English Bilinguals

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Abstract: In a similar experiment to Wilson & Gick (2014; JSLHR), who investigated the articulatory settings of French-English bilinguals, the present study is focused on Japanese-English bilinguals of various proficiencies. We analyze interspeech posture (ISP), and look at the differences between individuals and whether this is correlated with the perceived nativeness of the speakers in each of their languages.
